SUCCESS

IT IS NOT JUST HARD WORK

- We may have struggled for years and even reached some of our goals but wound up feeling exhausted, our lives out of balance.
- Our Spirituality is something that is unique to us and comparison to others is not productive
- Success is whatever you make it mean.
 - We need to stop judging one another based on our definition of success.
 - Too often we forget that we all are on different journeys and it is the pursuit not the end result that is important.
 - Sometimes that judgement comes from ourselves.
